Cultivation:

Cash crop and forage growing farms. Preferably early to mid sowing dates, at very high yield expectations

Sowing:

Time of sowing	20th of September until 25th of October
Seed rate	locally adapted

Straw:

Plant height	medium
Lodging resistance	
Necking resistance	
Plant growth regulators	slightly lower

Rhynchosporium	
Brown rust	
Plant protection	Early sowing: insecticide against aphids (BYDV), low disease pressure universal fungicides in EC 39 (+ 49)
